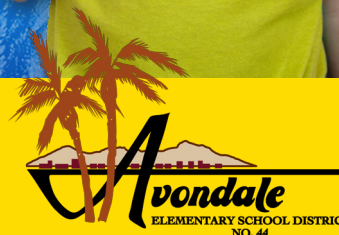

TERMS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- 1** Students have to graduate from the Michael Anderson School as well as the Agua Fria Union High School District to qualify.
- 2** The scholarship commitment is made to students enrolled in third grade at Michael Anderson School on April 4, 2012.
- 3** Students must remain a member of this class through high school graduation.
- 4** To receive the scholarship, students will have to demonstrate financial need. This criterion will be considered met if the student qualifies for the free and reduced lunch program at school in their senior year of high school.
- 5** Students must first maximize other scholarship opportunities.



ROSZTOCZY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

- 1** The scholarship covers cost of tuition, room and board at any Arizona state university.
- 2** The scholarship covers cost of tuition and books for any Arizona community college.
- 3** Any student attending an accredited private or public post-secondary institution other than an Arizona state university or Arizona community college may be eligible for funding up to the maximum available to those students attending the comparable in-state university or community college.
- 4** The student must maintain a 2.0 grade point average in college. The student's scholarship may be reinstated if he/she brings his/her GPA back up to a 2.0 or higher.
- 5** The student must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per term and make regular progress toward a degree.
- 6** The scholarship is good for a maximum of 4 consecutive years.
- 7** Students who graduate from college in less than 4 years can use the scholarship for graduate school fees and costs.

INCENTIVE FOR MICHAEL ANDERSON SCHOOL

- 1** It is assumed that between April 4, 2012 and May, 2017 when this class graduates from eighth grade there will be some students leaving the class and new students joining the class. Those new students do not qualify for the initial program.
- 2** However, starting in fourth grade, if the test scores for the entire class of students beats the national average on a national standardized test, then all students who have joined the class after April 4, 2012 will qualify for this scholarship program under the same terms as the initial group of kids.
- 3** This opportunity to earn more scholarships will continue through eighth grade.
